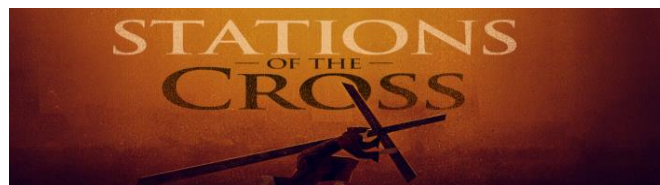

ANNIVERSARY

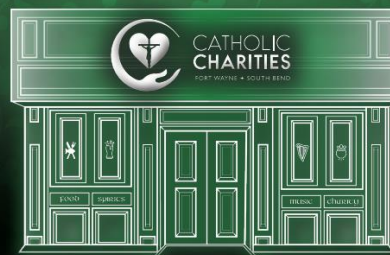
We have two special events planned for the Blessed Sacrament 150th Jubilee. Please plan on joining us!
